We will be focusing on writing simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

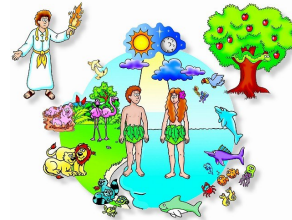
### Maths
