I want to talk to you about the concept of boyfriends and girlfriends at school. Although it may seem 'cute' that the children are coming home saying that they are 'married' to another child or that they are boyfriends and girlfriends this is something we do not advocate in school.

We have been getting more and more comments about children feeling uncomfortable with the concept of 'liking' someone or being 'liked' and although as adults we are used to the concept it can be quite frightening for a child and we do not merely brush this off.

We are also finding that more and more children are kissing during playtime and again this is something we ask the children not to do as it puts pressure on the children and it is not appropriate behaviour at school.

We understand that children experiment with relationships and this is normal and they play games involving being 'mummies and daddies' and again we know this is normal. However, we are working hard, supporting the children in understanding in the following:

- What healthy relationships are
- The importance of stopping when someone says no
- Appropriate touch
- Different types of relationships
