Fingers crossed we stay on the straight and narrow with Covid!



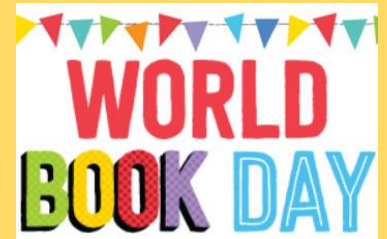
## Parent and carer's questionnaire
