We will have a whole day of exciting and stimulating activities for children on that day.

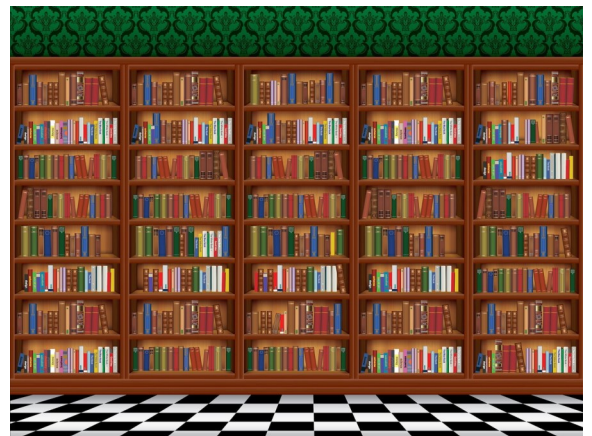
We are teaming up with the British Library to use their "Step inside your story" work as a stimulus for our day.

The idea behind "Step inside your story" is to gift children the opportunity to create a book in which they are the central character. Classes will explore this in different ways and we'll use videos from Children's Laureate Joseph Coelho and story teller Mara to help us.

All classes will have a library session during the day and teachers are busy planning some fun activities to do during this time. Maybe you'll listen to a great story or perhaps you'll be involved in a scavenger hunt, looking for things in books.



Costumes have always been a fun part of World Book Day at Oxenhope. This year, if your child would like to, they can come to school dressed as a word. This can be something simple, such as 'green' wearing all green clothes or you can go to town with 'discombobulated' if you wish. Please don't spend any money! During the day, children will work on a vocabulary based activity using the words they've come dressed as.
