

Year 3 homework. Autumn 1.

Below are some ideas and prompts for homework. The expectation is that children will complete one piece of homework per week. This is to be uploaded on Dojo in your child's individual portfolio. I will then look at it and comment on it. The ideas below are just that - ideas! If your child has a different idea, please feel free to go with it. As long as it links to some learning we are doing in school, they can do whatever they like. I have listed ideas under subject headings and while I haven't overloaded you with the entire curriculum, this will hopefully give you an insight into what we are learning about to enable you to support your child's learning at home.

English - sentence writing focussing on punctuation. Focus on capital letters and full stops initially then include question marks, exclamation marks and commas.

Maths - place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division. There is LOADS on line for these areas of learning.

Science - forces and magnetism. Can you find some things in your house which are magnetic? How about thinking about the forces happening in your house—which items need a push or pull force? Can you see friction in action? How about gravity?

History - Through the ages. Bronze age to iron age. Could you create a timeline for the changes that happened in this historical period?

DT - can you use what you've learnt in DT at school to build something at home? Could you make it have a moving part?

Computing - using computers to draw. Can you draw a picture on your device?

RE - Can you create a story board of the story of Noah?

Work can be presented in any way you choose. Art work, computer work, models, posters, written work. You can share your learning however you like as long as you upload at least one piece to Dojo each week.

Please remember to also be reading your reading book and working on your times tables each week.
