Hello! Year 6 and welcome to your new year group. I am very excited to welcome you back and I hope you have had a wonderful time over the 6 weeks holidays. English Our first topic this year is called 'Crime and punishment'. We will be learning about how crime and punishment has changed through-out history. We will also be looking at how the our nation has been affected by the different judicial systems it has been through. We will also be looking at the topic of fairness when discussing how individuals have been punished.

English

In English this year we shall be consolidating skills we have learn from previous year groups along with learning new skills that will help us to create cohesive and creative pieces of writing. We will be using a book based learning model where we will be using a specific text to help with our learning. This half-term in particular we will be refreshing our minds on the basic punctuation required and adding some new learning such as the use of semi-colons. We will be focusing our writing on narrative pieces that require us to engage the reader using exciting vocabulary for describing atmosphere and setting.

Maths

This half term we are putting an emphasis on learning about place value and addition/subtraction. We shall be focusing on practicing the formal method for calculations and using this within a variety of contexts including word problems.

R.E

Our current big question in Re is How can following God bring freedom and Justice? We will be discussing the life of Moses and the introduction of the 10 commandments. We will be talking about what is fair and how people should lead their lives.
