Hello Year 6 and welcome back after half-term. I am very excited to welcome you back and am looking forward to another exciting half-term together.

Our first topic this year is called 'Exploring our world'. We will be learning about the world around us and focusing on the different biomes across the continents. We will be using map work to identify many of the world's features. We will also be discussing the changes that could occur to our world that could happen in the coming years.

English

In English this half term we are going to be focusing our writing around non-fiction work. We are going to be learning about the use of different features that make a non-chronological report. We will also be looking at the use of subject specific language within a piece of writing. We will also be developing our knowledge of formality and how this can affect the way information is presented within a text.

Maths

This half term we are putting an emphasis on learning about fractions, decimals and percentages. We shall be focusing on practicing the formal method for calculations and using this within a variety of contexts. We will be going on to applying this learning to reasoning and problem solving questions.

R.E

Our current big question in Re is 'Creation and science: conflicting or complimentary? We will be discussing the creation of the world and the different theories on how it came to be. We will be discussing whether we think that science and the belief in the creation story can work hand in hand or whether we think they are completely separate.
