Hello Year 6 and welcome back after our Christmas break. I am very excited to welcome you back and am looking forward to another exciting half-term together.

Our first topic this year is called 'The golden age of Islam'. We will be learning about the Islam faith and how the Golde Age of Islam helped to shape the world and even Oxenhope. We will be using map work to identify trade routes. We will also be discussing the way that trade helped to change the world from China all the way to England.

### English

In English this half term we are going to be focusing our writing around writing an informal letter. We are going to be looking at formality within a piece of writing and being able to select the appropriate register for the work we are completing. We will also be looking at the use of subject specific language within a piece of writing. We will also be continuing to develop our knowledge on punctuation and developing our understanding of using hyphens within our work.

### Maths

This half term we are going to be focusing on shape including finding area, perimeter and volume within a shape. We will also be looking at applying our knowledge of the four operations whilst using decimal numbers including different real world applications such as with money and measures. We will also be learning how to calculate the percentage of an amount and the fraction of an amount.

### R.E

Our current big question in Re is 'Why is a pilgrimage important to some religious believers? We will be learning about a variety of pilgrimages form a range of religions. We will also be discussing why people go on pilgrimages and why it helps them with their faith. We will then talk about how those who do or do not complete pilgrimages might feel about the experience.

### Uniform and attendance
