Topic



Our topic this half term is *Everyday Superheroes!*

As well as thinking about what our own superpowers might be, we will explore the wonderful book *Supertato*.



We will also learn about real-life heroes in our community—including the police, fire service, RNLI, doctors, and nurses. Finally, we will celebrate our own school superheroes who keep us safe and happy every day, such as our cleaners, dinner ladies and office staff. We will

have the opportunity to ask them questions about their role and how they have helped others



In maths we will be learning about how to group and share numbers equally and will be applying our knowledge of number to different contexts.

We will also be preparing the children for transition into Year 1.



Assessments & home learning

Over the next few weeks, we will assess the children's understanding to see if they have reached their Early Learning Goals (ELGs). We will share these results with you in their end-of-year reports. Please continue to listen to your child read every day, as this daily practice remains vital to their ongoing progress.
