## English

We will continue to practise the year one grammar and punctuation skills. Focusing on: sentences with 'and' and 'because', full stops, finger spaces, capital letters,

adjectives, question marks, exclamation and tense.

Pupils will continue to cover place value within 100. Pupils will also learn how to tell the time, weight and capacity, division and multiplication.

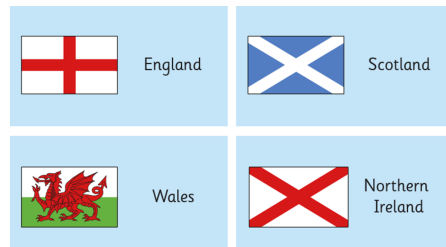
## Music

## Summer 2 - Homework ideas

Draw a picture of the United Kingdom and label the countries, capital cities and the seas that surround it.

Create a poster showing your understanding of the seasons and how the weather changes.



Learn the months of the year. Write which months are in each season.

Practice telling the time. Ask your child to 'stop and point to the clock' when it is o'clock or half past. The children love doing this!

Create your own maths or phonics board game to bring to class and play with a friend.

Practice using question marks. Ask Miss Lovett or Miss Hopkinson anything!
